## TOWN OF THURMAN FUND BALANCE POLICY

Creating a strong fund balance can help mitigate risk and sustain the town during economic downturns. Fund balance can ensure the consistent delivery of essential services. It also provides for necessary funds to respond to natural disasters, to fund capital improvements, and build a strong credit rating. The intent of this policy is to provide written specifications as to the scope and purpose of the fund by defining what the funds shall be used for, setting a minimum fund level, and providing for the reimbursement of funds that are used for various needs. The Town of Thurman has approved five interest bearing accounts to hold funds for the following specific reasons:

**General Fund** – Fund balance to cover unexpected expenditures, capital improvements, and loss of expected revenue. A reasonable amount for this fund is determined to be three months of the general fund appropriations.

**C & D Closure Fund** – The DEC requires an annual deposit of \$50,000 for ten years to cover the cost of the C & D closure. This fund will have a deposit of \$50,000 at the beginning of each year. Currently there is \$100,000 in this fund for the 2022 and 2023 deposit.

**Highway Fund** – Fund balance to cover unexpected expenditures, natural disasters requiring road repair and equipment rental. A reasonable amount for this fund is determined to be three months of the highway fund appropriations.

**Highway Garage Fund** – This fund represents savings to allocate toward a new highway garage to help secure grants and/or loan. This fund was established with \$300,000 and increases will be determined by Town Board majority vote.

Highway Equipment Fund — This fund will be specifically for equipment and the amount will be determined annually at year end when the final fund balance is known. The Town Board will decide by majority vote. These funds are currently in NYCLASS, which is a no risk, high interest investment opportunity for municipalities. Funds are very liquid and can be moved between the Town checking accounts and the NYCLASS accounts with 24 hour notice. The Supervisor will have discretion to invest excess funds as long as they remain in the appropriate Fund (General / Highway) to take advantage of the interest, and can move the funds back to the town fund when needed. Any spending of these funds shall require town board approval.

**DISCUSSION:** Discussion ensued regarding developing a fund balance policy and a highway equipment fund.
