RESOLUTION TO REPLACE RESOLUTION 22 AND APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF ONE F-350 4X4 TRUCK FROM WARREN FORD

WHEREAS the Town Board passed Resolution 22 in January for the purchase of an F-350 4x4 truck to replace the one that was sold at auction last year, and

WHEREAS the truck that was voted on was not the truck that would be available right away as was originally thought, and

WHEREAS the truck that is readily available has a slightly higher price of \$74,964.00 and is still below the budgeted amount of \$75,000, be it

RESOLVED: The Town Board of the Town of Thurman approves the purchase of an F-350 truck from Warren Ford in the amount of \$74,964.00 to be paid from Account Code DA5130.2
